Foreword

In earlier times, a university was labelled as an “ivory tower” by the masses. Now a new metaphor “triple helix” is emerging as the institution becomes more embedded in society. Universities, governments, and industries are now described as the DNA strands of this triple helix, forming the dynamic building blocks of the knowledge economy. When the strands are healthy and interconnected, the helix produces the knowledge, know-how, and technology of prosperous societies. With this recognition, BUIITEMS efforts has been delineated to provide specialized training to students and staff; develop and transfer technologies to industry; and respond to numerous societal needs. 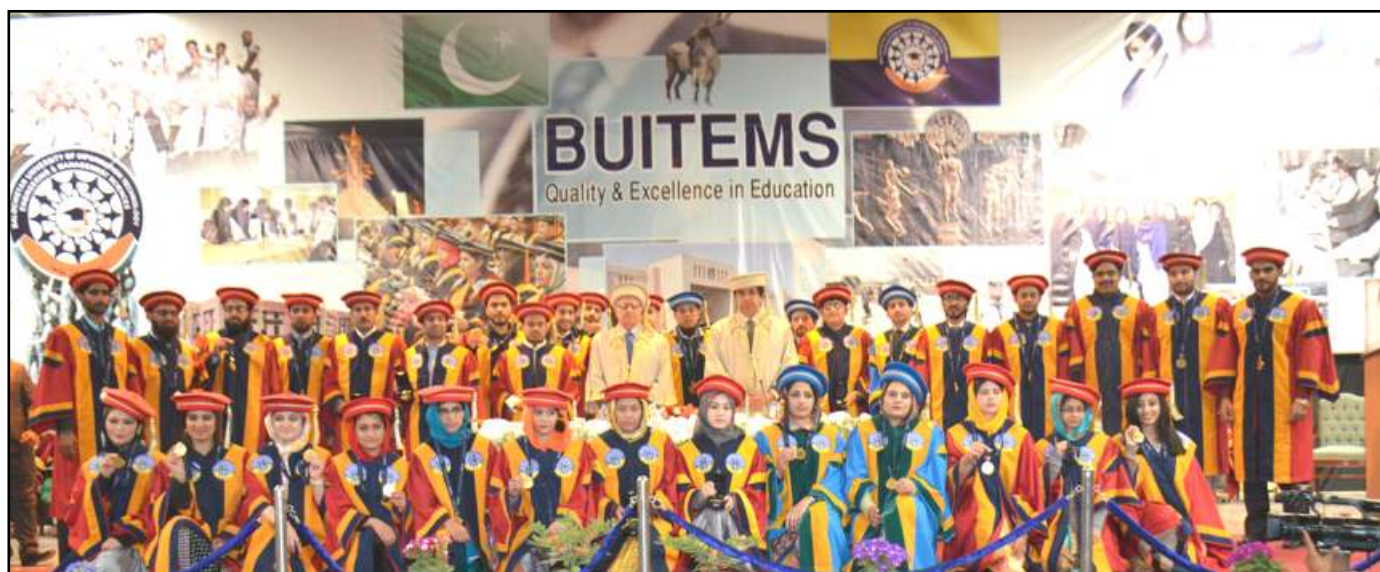
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Introduction

Ceremony for 4th outstanding research awards was held on March 13, 2015 at HEC office, Islamabad.



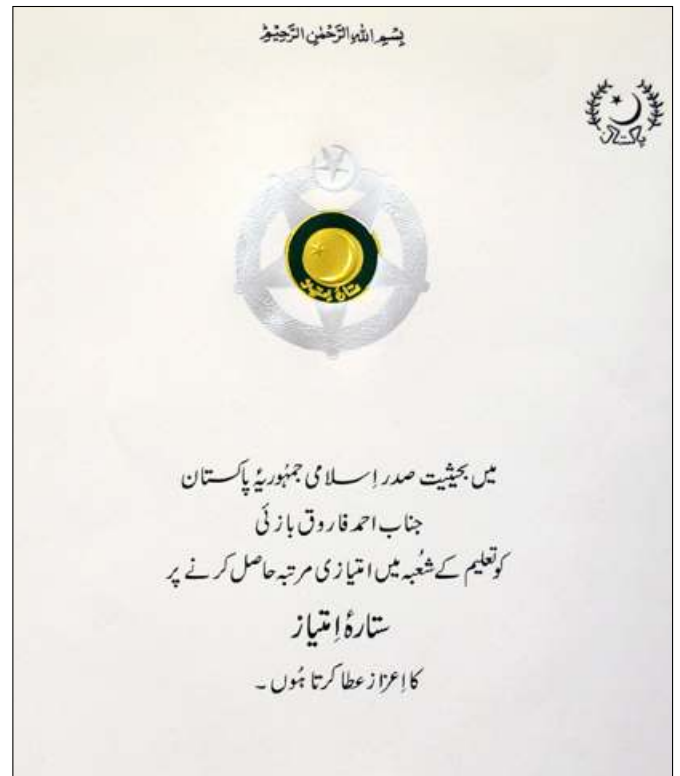

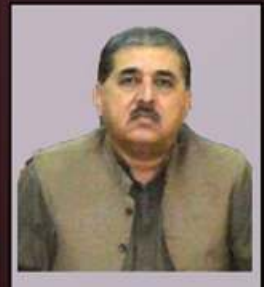

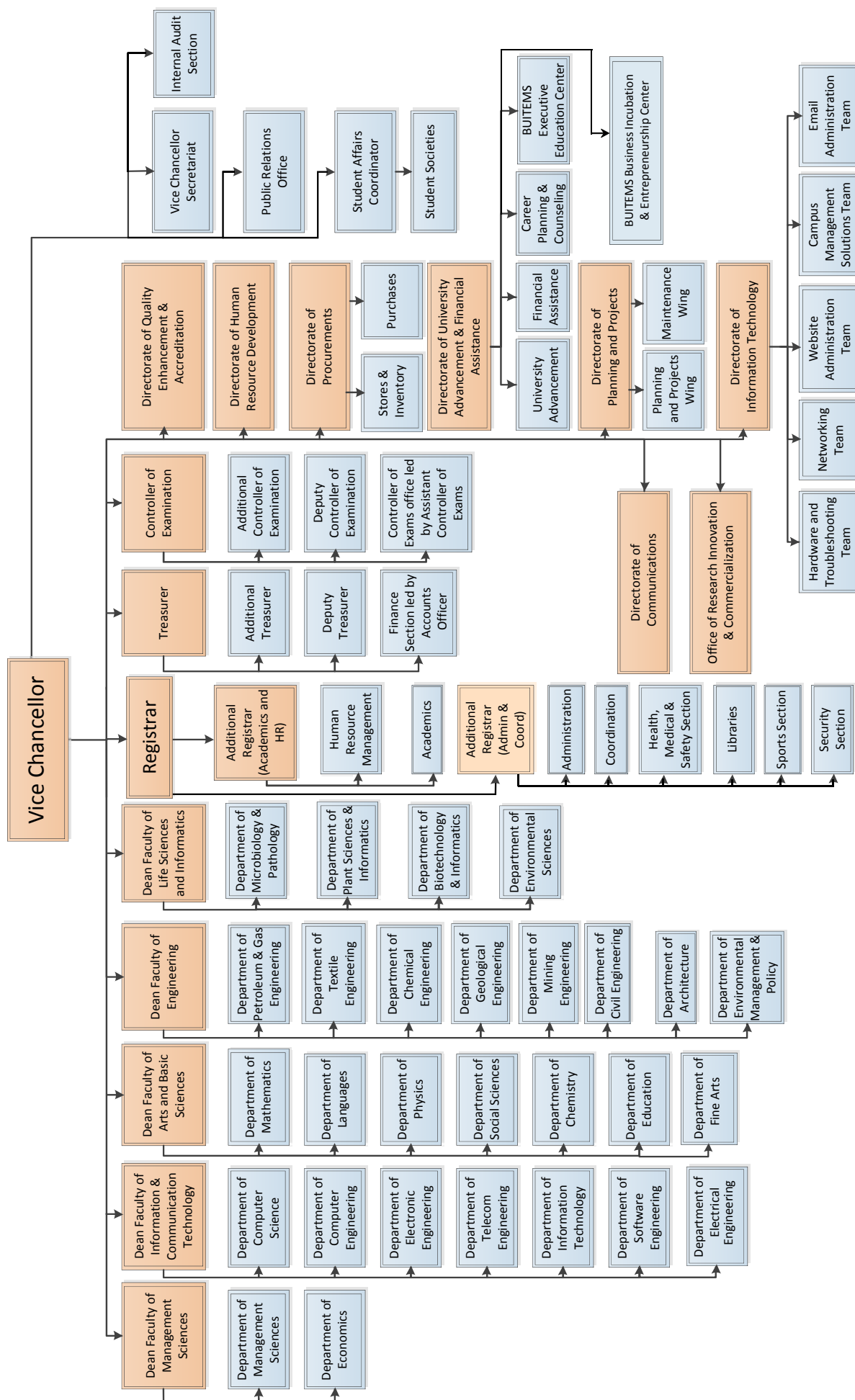

On Campus Recruitment Tests

Fifty six graduates from Management Sciences participated in the test and three were selected for appointment after panel interview on September 1, 2015. Mr. Rizwan Baig conducted the test while panelists for interview were Mr. Mujahid-ul-Mulk Butt (National Manager Sales), Mr. Faisal Iqbal (National Manager HR) and Ms. Tuba Iqbal (Assistant Manager HR). Habibullah Coastal Power Company (HCPC) (Pvt) Ltd. also conducted on-campus recruitment test at Takatu Campus, Orange Hall on November 27, 2015. Four graduates of the Faculty of Engineering were selected for appointment at HCPC Quetta, after comprehensive interview from amongst 116 graduates who appeared for the test. Maj (R) Muhammad Hussain Saif Manager Admin, HR and Security, and Mr. Zaheer Abbas Plant Manager, led the HCPC team to conduct this recruitment test and final selection. The third on-campus recruitment test was conducted by Tetra Pak on December 15, 2015. Graduates from the Departments of Electronic Engineering and Telecommunication Engineering appeared for this test. Tetra Pak team shortlisted 8 students for their systematic selection procedure scheduled in Lahore, and finally 4 graduates were selected. Tetra Pak selection team comprised Mr. Umair Younus, Mr. Muhammad Zubair, Mr. Ali Saqlain, Mr. Faqir Abdullah, and Mr. Salman Mughal.

BUITEMS and SEHER

An MoU was signed between BUITEMS and SEHER (Society for Empowering Human Resource) on April 1, 2015 at Vice Chancellor Secretariat, Takatu Campus. CUMT Xuzhou China and BUITEMS

On behalf of BUITEMS, Chairman Mining Engineering department Prof. Dr. Mohammad Ali Shah signed an MoU with China University of Mining & Technology (CUMT) Xuzhou on November 2, 2015. The counter signatory was Mr. Wang Wenjie, Deputy Director International Office CUMT.



Under the MoU linkage program, CUMT offered 07 scholarships every year for five years. Two scholarships from China Scholarship Council (CSC) are fully funded by the Ministry of Education, Government of China, plus 3000 Yuan (RMB) stipend per month. Five CUMT scholarships are partially funded including tuition fee waiver, free medical insurance and hostel facility.

The conference proved to be prolific as it provided a platform for the researchers, scholars, and academicians to share their experiences and knowledge on emerging issues in the field of economics and management.

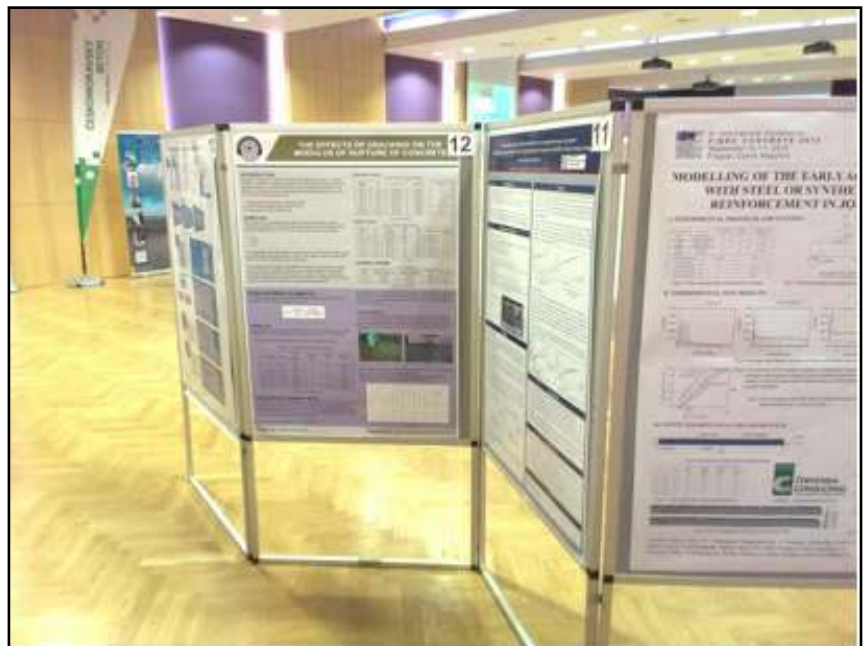

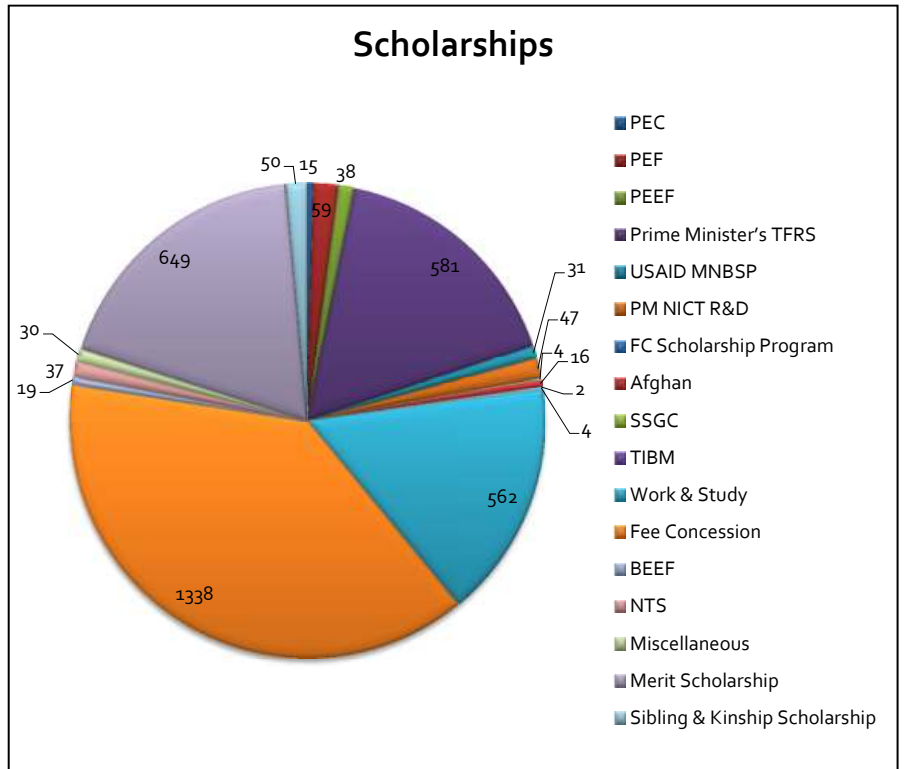


Work-Study Program

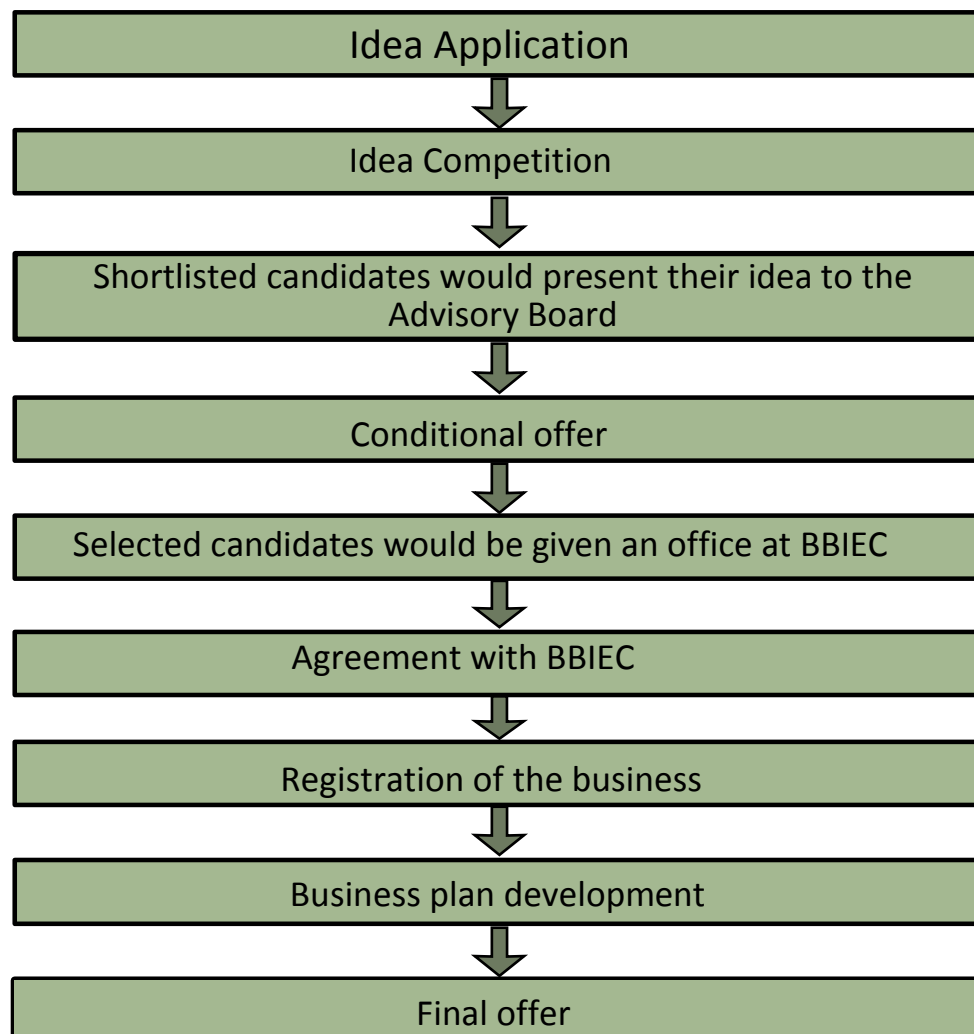

Inter-Varsity Talent Gala & House of The Year Trophy-2015

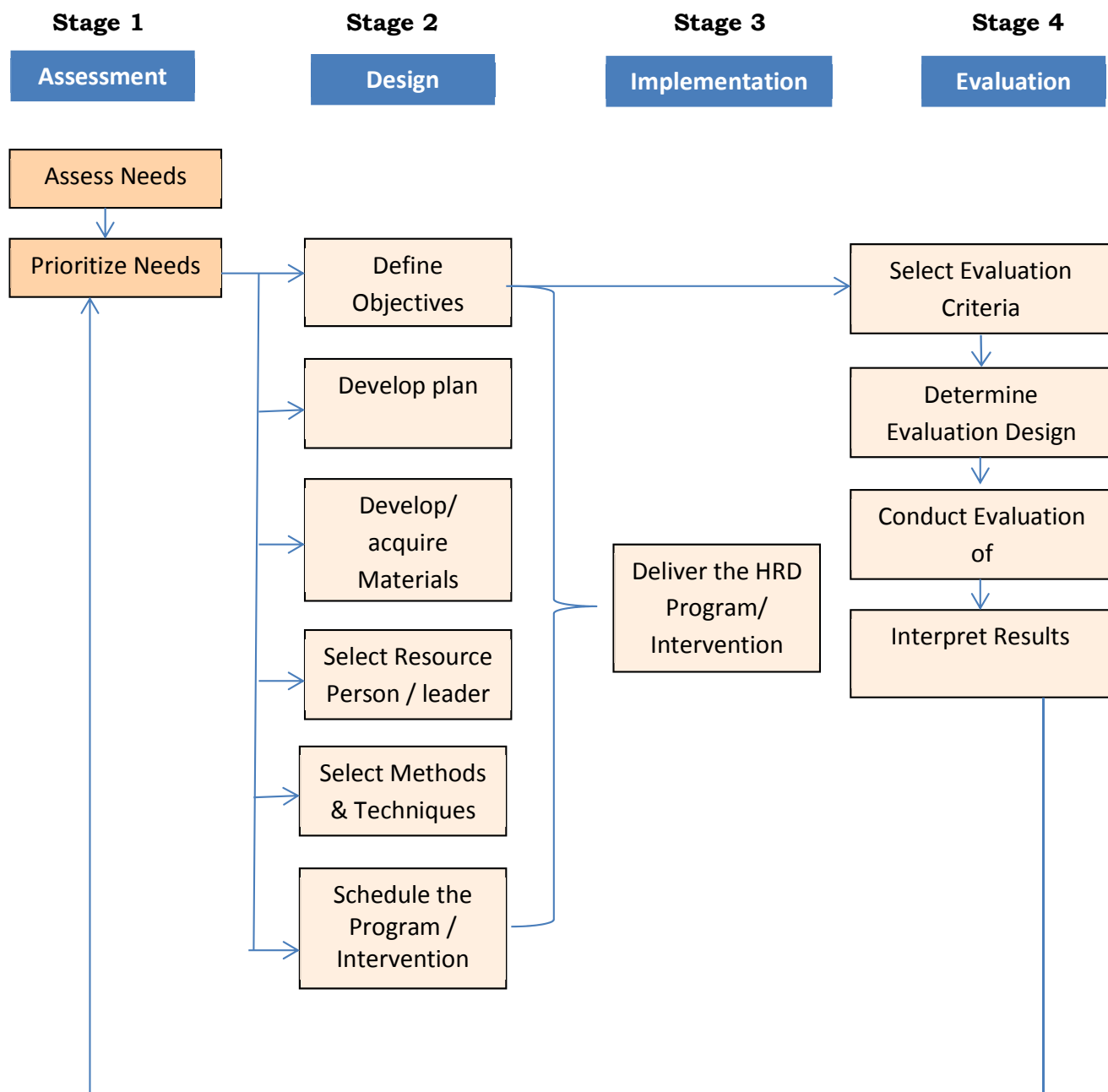

BUIITEMS FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial Highlights

In order to ensure that BUIITEMS continue to grow and remain competitive, a plan was initiated to boost up revenue generation. The statutory bodies appreciated the proposal for sorting the ways and means to replenish financial resources to cater the financial needs. As the University is expending, its appropriated strategic investment is increasing. Therefore, University's cash investment/non-current investments have also been increasing. BUIITEMS has generated funds to enable it to initiate new academic programs, acquire technological development and equipment, maintenance of infrastructure and increasing building capacity.

BUIITEMS has been imparting quality education since 2002. BUIITEMS is in its development phase and at this stage the proper funding, both for its Development and Recurring expenditure, remains crucial for its growth, development and imparting quality education. Annual Budget for the financial year 2014-15 was approved to the tune of Rs.985.325 million, which was revised to Rs.781.201 million. The earning/receipt of the University in the year 2013-14 was Rs.135.00 million which increased to Rs.140.00 million during 2014-15. The major contribution in increased revenue is attributed to efficient financial management and enrolment of new students in newly established departments/programs.

Upgradation of PeopleSoft Campus Management Solution

Campus Management Solution, an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) software, was deployed in the year 2009 with an aim to automate the manual processes of universities and bring agility in employees' functionality. Over the period of last 7 years considerable improvement has been recorded in the output. Feeling the need of time, the People Tools were upgraded from 8.49 to 8.53 with latest stable bundles of 32. ORACLE database was also enhanced to 11g R2.

Robust servers like HP ProLiant DL580 Gen8 and DL380 Gen 9 along with HP MSA 2040 storage and MSL 2024 Tape drives were also purchased to provide robust access to user and securing scheduled backup of the applications.



Distribution of assets under Prime Minister National Laptop Scheme

Prime Minister National Laptop Scheme phase-I was initiated in BUIITEMS with support of Prime Minister schemes and Higher Education Commission to encourage and motivate talented students of university for pursuing higher education. The IT team played an integral role to make this scheme transparent and complaint free. Help desks were established to guide the potential students on how to apply; create a profile and validate their record through online portals. As a result one hundred and twenty one laptops/bags and EVO devices were distributed to MS/PhD students, and one thousand and nineteen laptops/bags and EVO devices to BS students, successfully. The success of this scheme in BUIITEMS was considered as a model by Higher Education Commission for all other regional HEIs.



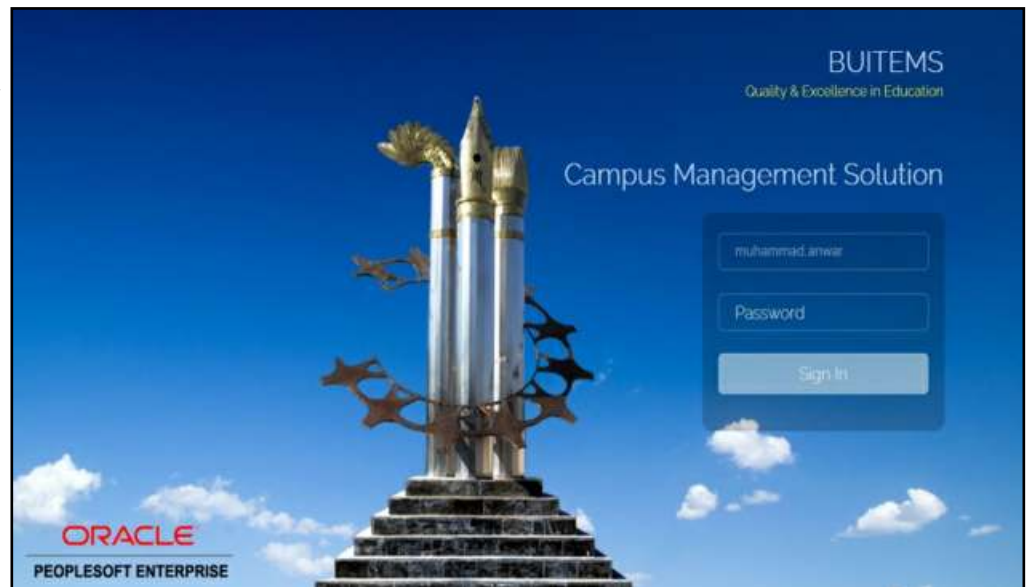
Establishment of CMS support desk

Directorate of IT believes in providing prompt and efficient support to all its colleagues. A dedicated help desk, namely “CMS support desk” was established in Sir Syed Block, Takatu campus to deal and respond to all sorts of queries related to the operation of the Campus Management Solution (CMS) on time. Telephonic support is also provided.



Training sessions for CMS users

Various trainings were also imparted to new faculty and staff member during the year 2015. The major focus was to build their capacity through hands-on experience in computer labs. These trainings not only gave them an overview of CMS but also empowered them to utilize it in a more efficient manner. New manuals were developed for each training session.



Upgradation of e-Attendance system for staff

The old biometric attendance machines for the faculty were replaced by the facial recognition machines in both campuses. These machines were brought on to the centralized server machine for effective management and customized software was developed to help the Departments in monitoring their staff attendances.



Establishment of new computer labs

BUITEMS always appreciates the efforts of its partners in promoting the cause of higher education in the region. HBL foundation accordingly supported us in strengthening the IT infrastructure by establishing 04 computer labs with state of the art hardware mentioned below:

Access to this facility is granted through the Biometric Access control system such that it always remains open.

Strengthening of security through IP surveillance and digital communications

The security of students and staff has always been a priority of BUITEMS. High Definition IP surveillance system was deployed including PTZ, speed dome, fixed dome and bullet cameras of the world-class brand Samsung. For effective monitoring a control center is also established with 24x7 surveillance of the campus. The Icom wireless communication system is also provided to security personnel of the university to have effective communication between security check posts and entry point.



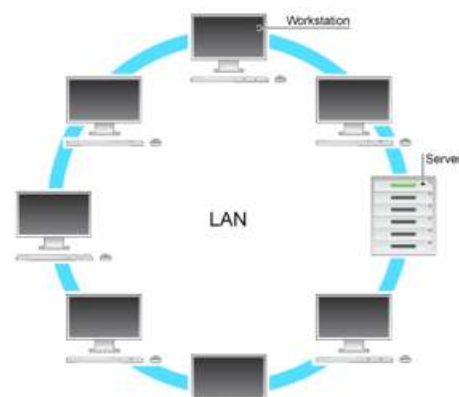
Live streaming of BUIITEMS 11th Convocation proceedings

Wireless Coverage

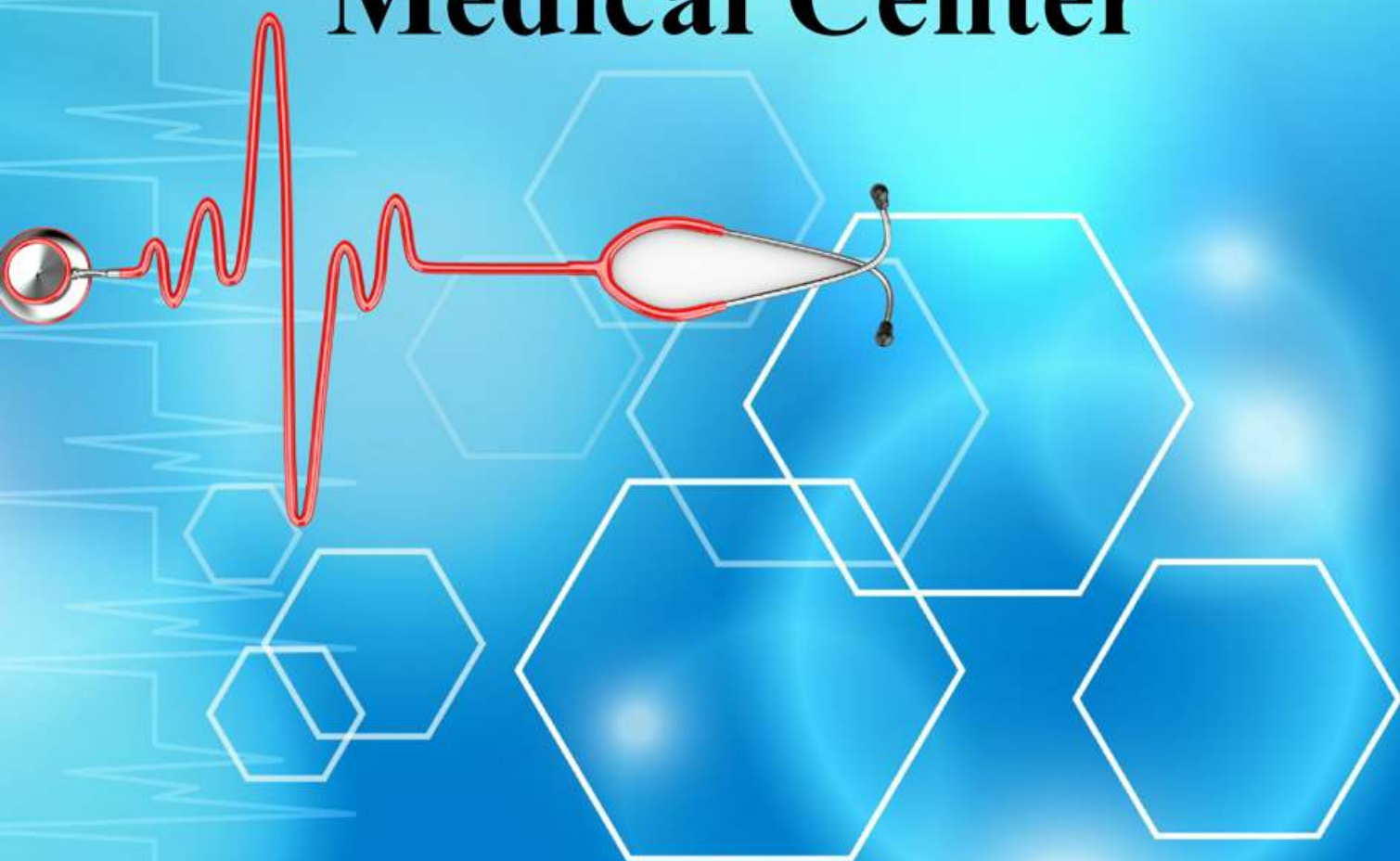
Students, staff and faculty in each building of Takatu campus have been provided wireless internet access by deploying over thirty Ubiquiti access points around campus.

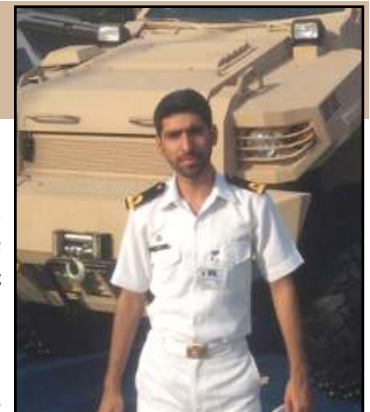


I completed my BS Telecommunication Engineering from the Department of Telecommunication Engineering, FICT BUITEMS.

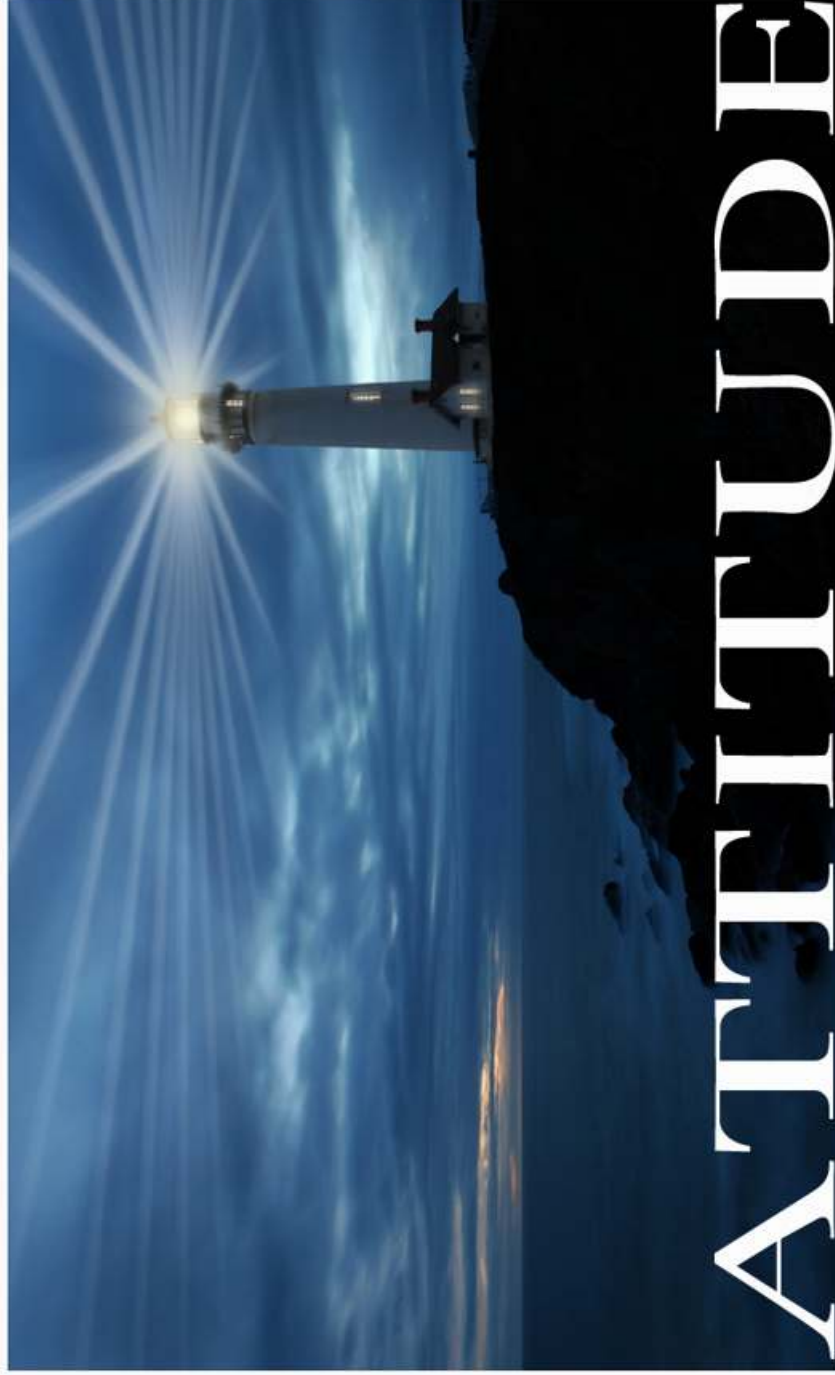
